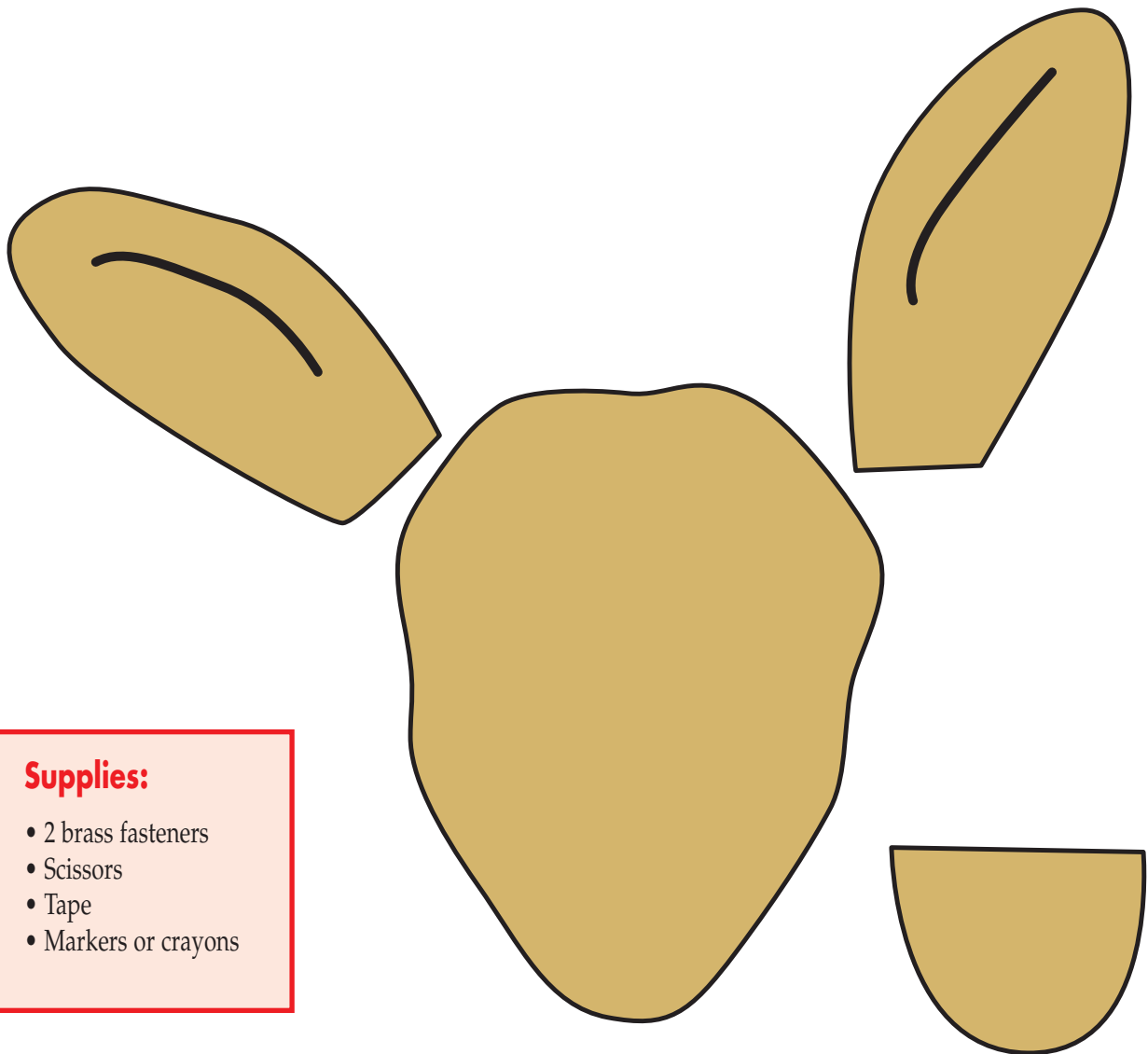




### Attentive Deer Craft

This craft is designed to create a reminder to be attentive in each situation you encounter. The attentive white-tailed deer is always moving its ears around so that it is alert to its surroundings. You must be certain your ears point in the direction they are listening, as well. To remind you of this, the deer's ears will be movable.

Cut the deer's head, mouth, and ears out. Draw eyes and a nose on the face. Use brass fasteners to attach the ears to the upper side of the deer's head. Tape the mouth to the back side of the head so that it will open and close. As you decorate your deer, think about the many ways the deer demonstrates attentiveness.



#### Supplies:

- 2 brass fasteners
- Scissors
- Tape
- Markers or crayons
